Through the community, you can also find a suite of resources to support you in your role. Please follow the directions provided in the invitation email to log in to the site. Once you have access to the BMC Series Editorial Community, we ask that you complete our **Welcome Course**. The course is designed to help you to familiarize yourself with the BMC Series and prepare for handling your first manuscript.

Unless you've specified an alternative start date in your response form, you can expect to start receiving invitations to handle manuscripts within the next 1-2 weeks. In the meantime, you will also receive access to our peer review system, and your name will be added to the journal website.

We will notify you via email when a suitable manuscript has been submitted that matches your expertise. The email will contain detailed instructions on what actions are required and we ask that you accept or decline the invitation as soon as possible.

Using the system - You will shortly be invited to our new Springer Nature Submission System and receive further instructions via email.

Invitations to handle manuscripts

- Where possible, please always try to respond to invitations to handle manuscripts, even if you need to decline. The reason for this is that when we invite Associate Editors to handle a manuscript, we usually handpick 3 or 4 board members with relevant academic expertise and 'queue' the invitations to you. Unfortunately, if you do not accept/decline through the system, this holds the manuscript up for some time while it waits for your response, until it automatically invites the next board member in the gueue.
- If you are temporarily busy or on holiday please let us know
- If you feel that you are receiving too many invites to handle manuscripts, or have an idea of how many manuscripts you'd like to handle a month, please let me know – I can update our records to meet your preferences.

2. Peer review

- We understand that sometimes it can be difficult to find peer reviewers. If you are struggling, helpful information on the resources and tools you can use to find reviewers can be found here.

- 4. Ongoing training and webinars
- From time to time, we host informative webinars on various aspects of the responsibilities of the editorial board which have been really popular with our board members, to find out more about these, visit the Events Channel on the Editorial Site.

- If you see a manuscript published/going through peer review that you think deserves promotion e.g. through social media or a press release, please let me know.
- There are opportunities to write blogs about manuscripts you find really interesting, if you have an idea we can make arrangements to formally pitch your idea to our internal communications team.
