The In-Country Scholarship Programme "Prospects for Peace Through Education in Iraq" is commissioned by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ)" and implemented by GIZ in close cooperation with DAAD.

Within the programme, a two-part selection process is implemented to identify the most suitable candidates for the programme.

The first part serves to determine whether the applicants are part of the target group of the programme.

In the second part, reviewers assess the applicants' academic merit as well as their motivation.
