#### 7. Course overview:

This course (general English for university students) builds academic proficiency in language skills of language required for lectures, tutorials, reading the research, and written assignments. It is designed to be taught to first-year students to develop their ability to communicate; comprehend new concepts. ### **11. Assessment Scheme**

Students are assessed depending on their exam results. Marks are given based on students' performance in the exams as follows:

1. First monthly exam 20%, so, 15% (Speaking), and 5% Listening

2. Second monthly exam 20% (Reading, Vocabulary, Writing)

3. Final exam 60% (Speaking 20M, listening 10M, and Reading, Vocabulary, Writing 30M)
