2- Shrubs Lecture 8

This group of plants is quite common in Kurdistan and quite wide spread all over the world as well. Its height generally not exceed 3 meters but it may extent to more than that normally in branched form. In the present proposed garden, it will have made up the second layer in respect to height stratification of the plantation. However, often such shrubs are used as fence with various species and types in different gardens. Shrubs in Kurdistan are mainly belonging to (*Nerium oleander, Rosa canina, Rubus caesius, Rubus sanctus* etc.) in Kurdistan shrubs are mainly used for decoration. Apart from trees, shrubs are used and planted for the shade, shadow and shelter purposes also.

Owns shrubs as in trees a number of qualities formalism which earned value coordinating task in parks and gardens and by species and length of flowering where vary forms of leaves, flowers and fruit and nature fork twigs and shape the legs and the speed of growth and unsustainable environmental conditions like brushed temperature, humidity and soilborne Shearing and configuration. Given the large number of types of shrubs and the multiplicity of forms and heights so it has long divided into bushes heights ranging between 2.5-3.5 and another medium-high rise of 1.5-2, either the final set are of small shrubs to a maximum height of 1 m.

As for the forms of shrubs has been divided into:

## **Spreading Shrubs**

This is characterized by the proliferation of growth and offshoots therefore need places into vast somewhat to reach their best and used when intended fill a vacuum as in the garden plants, they grow and spread and cover large areas examples jasmine and Verbina Shrub either form the other is.

## **Sprawling shrubs**

Characterized that shrubs be based on the earth's surface everything from papers or leaflets or branches secondary has to take these branches to grow to the point that it more than height of the tree if there was room in the place cultivated it as in the types of jasmine and Rose and there.

### **Recurving shrubs**

These are semi-List where branching takes shape arched or weeping in some cases. A beautiful plant that can be used in gardens to give a beautiful shape on the borders of landscaping and water. It can also be used in many places gardens where intended Acquisition place a unique and sustainable and should not trim the bushes trim normal but take into account only removing undesirable branches until Unchangeable form Shrub and subsidiarity Examples include curved Jasmine.

#### **Erect shrubs**

# Importance of shrubs in landscaping and parks.

Can highlight the role of coordinating shrubs as follows: -

- 1- Grown leafy shrubs and flowering to replace large trees in the gardens and small spaces because the high shrubs and flowers supply coffee instinct. *Callistemon lives* in colours, green narrow spaces instead of trees.
- 2- Planted shrubs, green curtains and vase in front of the walls, and down trees to clothe their leaves, stumps, broad *Ligustrum* and *Dodonaea viscose*.
- 3- Some bushes give flowers suitable for picking and coordination, including colourful flowers with the beautiful smell of jasmine, including beauty in Euophrbia.
- 4- Different flowers and shrubs season by different mismatched flowers in spring or summer, autumn or winter may continue some flowering throughout the year, such as bougainvillea plants arranged in the form of bushes to give flowers all year round.
- 5- Some sustainable small evergreen shrubs can be formed for the necessary forms of coordination, appear spherical, tent, and conical, and frequently use this coordination in engineering gardens fashioned *Myrtus communis* and *Dodonaea viscose*.
- 6-Planted shrubs around buildings to connect the park building; there are several points to consider when planting shrubs in the gardens. They can be planted on the bodies of various dimensions with no exaggeration to show the character and beauty of each shrub, including those characterized by the beauty of the colour of leaves, as in *Duranta plumieri* spotted or the beauty of flowers.
- **7-Landscape your property line**. Putting shrubs along your property line can serve you in a number of ways such as providing privacy, marking boundaries, and offering wind protection. Be respectful with the shrubs you choose, and maintain them frequently so as not to offend your neighbors with wild, unkempt landscaping.


10. Soften hardscapes. Adding shrubs around foundations, pools, patios, and decks can soften the look of hard edges, plus bring some privacy to your space.
