Students from selected schools in the US, Jordan and Iraq join together on a binational team and collaborate via virtual exchange to make a difference in their community while developing workforce readiness skills. Binational teams compete in this virtual business competition to design the most innovative sustainable solution to a challenge related to the UN's Sustainable Development Goals.

Top three finalist teams are awarded a small grant to further develop their concept.

- Finalist team members will receive a stipend to participate in additional online professional development course from a university in the United States
- Finalist team members are awarded a small grant to further develop their concept
