

Dear Grantee,

We wish to express our sincere congratulations on your Grant awarded by the Italian Government for the academic year 2018 - 2019.

We hope that your study abroad experience in Italy will be productive and enjoyable, and that you will return home with an increased and valuable wealth of knowledge.

Below, you will find a list of useful instructions to help you throughout your next steps.

In order to accept the Grant you declare, under your responsibility that you:

- are duly informed that the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation has the right to suspend
- have obtained a study VISA issued by the Italian Diplomatic Mission in your country and that the VISA is valid for the
- are duly informed and accepts the terms of payment in three-monthly instalments;
- are duly aware that the Grant will not cover any study periods abroad;
- are not contemporarily a beneficiary of any other Grants sponsored by the Italian Government or any other Italian priv
- are duly informed that failure to comply with commitments as mentioned below will result in forfeit of Grant payments

Moreover, you declare to be committed to the following terms:

- to strive to meet the academic goals for which you were selected;
- to duly notify the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of any need of leaving from Italy during the period of the Grant program;
- to send, via e-mail to your own contact person at the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation within 14 days from the beginning of the Grant, the following documents:
 1. The Self-Declaration Affidavit (Modulo di Dichiarazione sostitutiva di certificazione per vincitori di borsa), duly dated and properly signed, which is available at related section in Grant menu;
 2. Copy of the passport;
- to send any other documentation as requested by the International Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation;
- to be aware that renouncing the Grant after having accepted it will subsequently imply the exclusion from future call for application for Grants awarded by the Italian Government. The renunciation must be notified with a signed letter to the relevant Italian Diplomatic Mission and to your contact person at the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation.

You authorize the use of personal data in accordance with Law 675/96, "Tutela delle persone e di

altri soggetti rispetto al trattamento dei dati personali", with Legislative Decree 196/2003 and with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) (Regulation (EU) 2016/679).

The lack of confirmation within 15 days from the reception of this notification will be interpreted as an implicit withdrawal from the Grant program.

After having sent the confirmation you shall receive from the Embassy the following document: "Dichiarazione di accettazione".

This document is necessary in order to apply for your VISA and, after your arrival in Italy, for the "Permit to stay".
