

Mapping: Diagraming or making a map helps you gather ideas and find out how these ideas are related to each other.



Making a list: providing a list of the ideas and examples is very useful to help you prioritize and structure your paragraphs and evidences for supporting them.

Pre-writing Editing Vs Post-Writing Editing

Editing: Consider the following free writing:

The topic is "Advantages of becoming a teacher in Kurdistan". Teachers play a very significant role in our lives. My teacher is my modal. Teachers are very respectful people. They raise generations. Teachers are the reasons why we have achieved this freedom. Teachers are very underpaid in Kurdistan. They have lightened our path. Teachers should do another job besides their current occupations. I think we all owe them so much. I have learnt and achieved so much. Teachers have always supported the revolution.

Pre-writing Editing

- We should go over the free writing and try to structure our paragraphs according to the ideas and examples provided. Consider the different colors on the previous slide. A classification of ideas supported by evidence helps you establish the ideas to be discussed in each paragraph of your writing. Each color is raw material for a separate paragraph, with the orange color representing *irrelevant* ideas.
- ➤ Post-Writing editing includes going over the writing after it is finished searching for unity, logicality, evidences, and language issues.
