## **The road:**

## **The Street:**

Aims to facilitate public interaction.

Defining a street as a road for vehicles is not the same as designing it as a 'path'.

The path :

- has both a **beginning** and an **end**, definite places or nodes with **special use and activity** along its length.
- such paths present to the observer a memorable image of connected places.

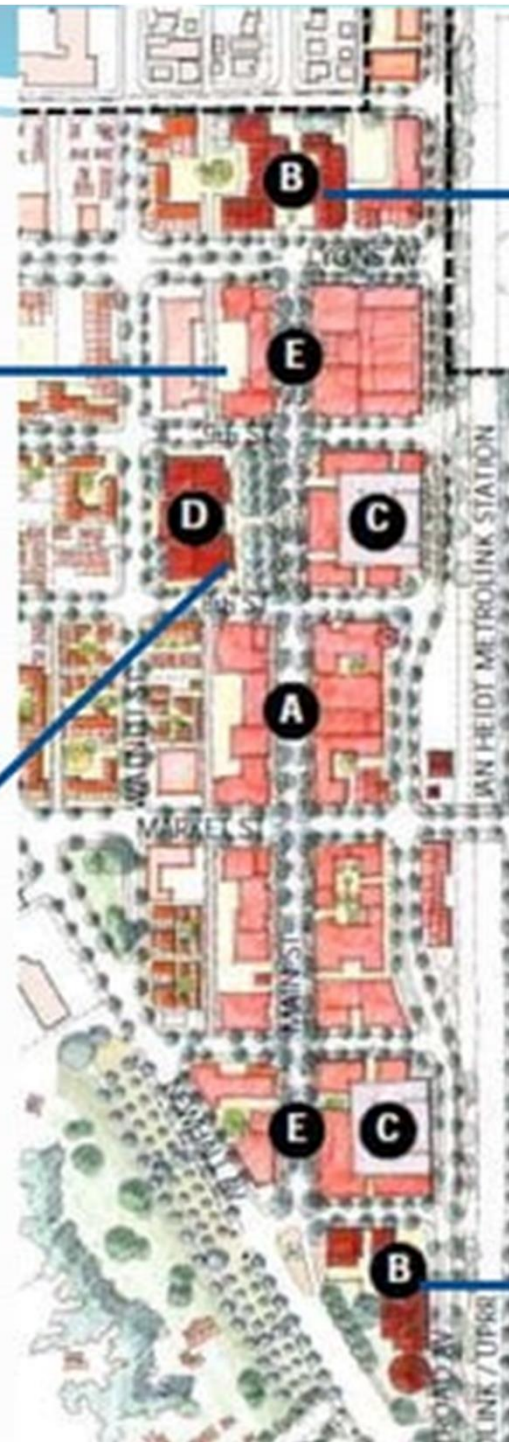


## Designing the street as a path:
